As a large group, identify the most pressing challenges discussed and brainstorm potential cross-cutting solutions or areas for further research.

#### 5. Wrap-up and Call to Action

- Summarize main takeaways
- Discuss how participants can continue to address these issues beyond the conference
- Share resources for further learning or involvement
